Architectural Appeal Process

Homeowners may request an appeal of an Architectural Change Request that has been disapproved by the Architecture Review Board

1. Homeowner must submit a written response to the Architectural Review Board within thirty days from disapproval. This response should include specific detailed information that clarifies why the initial Architectural Change Request should be reconsidered. Items rejected by the Committee in the initial request should be specifically addressed in this response.
2. If the Architectural Review Board disapproves an appeal, the homeowner may request a second appeal that will be administered by the Board of Directors. The second appeal must be submitted in writing within thirty days from disapproval of first appeal.
3. The decision of the Board of Directors is final and binding. Homeowners should contact the Community Management Company to be placed on the agenda of the Architectural Committee or of the Board of Directors.
